CALF CLUB

Judging starts at 10.00am

Calves **must not** be clipped or oiled.

Adults may assist to wash calves which arrive dirty, but any subsequent grooming or handling must be done by children only

TB POLICY: See Rules & Regulations. All calves must have in their ears the official primary and secondary AHB tags.

Dairy calves (heifers only) must be born between 1 June 2011 and 31 August 2011.

Beef calves (includes all bull and steer calves) must be

born between 1 June 2011 and 30 September 2011.

Dairy Calf Definitions:

Light Breed: Jersey, Ayrshire* moved from heavy
Heavy Breeds: Friesian, Dairy Shorthorn

Beef Calf Definitions:

Traditional: Dairy Bulls or Steers, Hereford, Angus, Murray Grey, Beef Shorthorn – Pure or crosses

Exotic: Limousin, Simmental, Belgian Blue, Charolais etc pure or crosses

Calves will be judged on Leading and Rearing, plus Dairy or Beef type.
